Required Scholarship Criteria:

1. Complete submission of application by March 15, 2024.
2. Graduating student must be a Napa County resident and enrolled in a Napa County High School or Napa Valley College student transferring to a 4-year State or University program.

To Apply: A *landmark* is an object or a feature of a landscape or town that has importance or makes a place easily recognizable. Historic landmarks in Napa County include built structures like buildings and bridges as well as district neighborhoods, parks and gardens that are at least 50 years old. Locate and describe a Napa County landmark that has significance to you. Why do you think it has value and is worth preserving? What would you do if it were threatened with demolition? The graduating student may submit their answers such as written form (under 500 words) or submit a video (no more than 5 minutes long).

Application Materials:

1. Completed '*Student Scholarship Application Cover Sheet*'.
2. Copy of student transcripts.
3. Two letters of recommendation.
