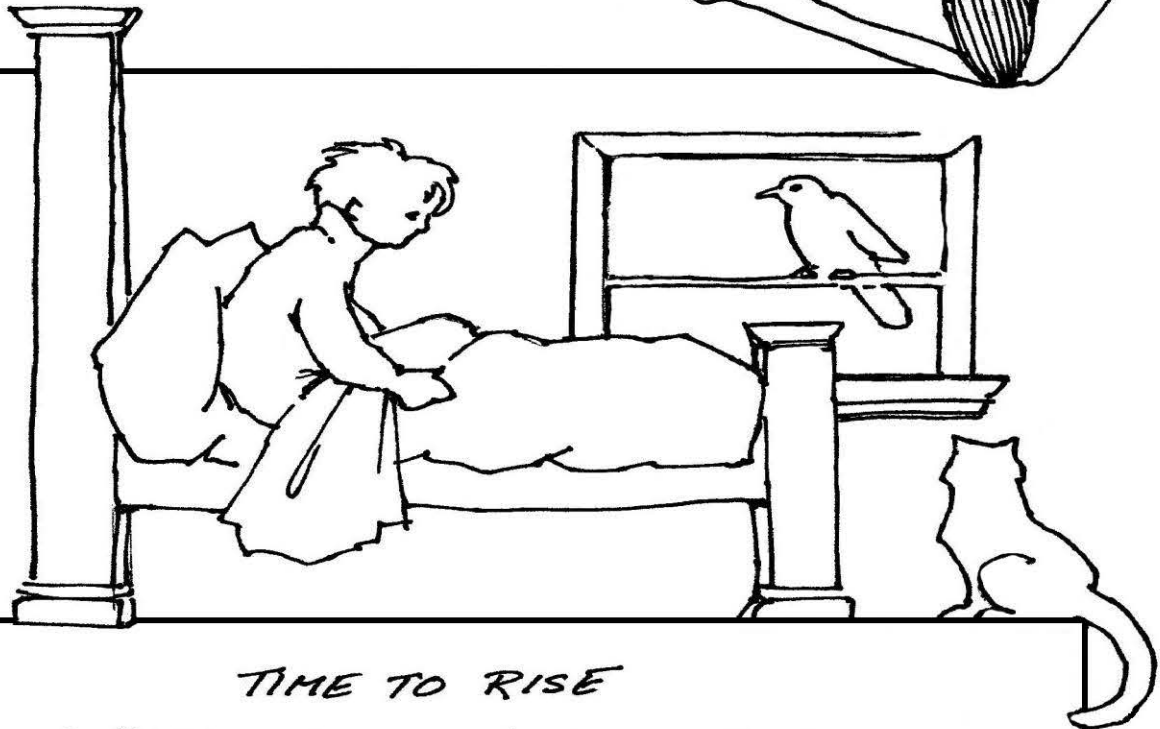
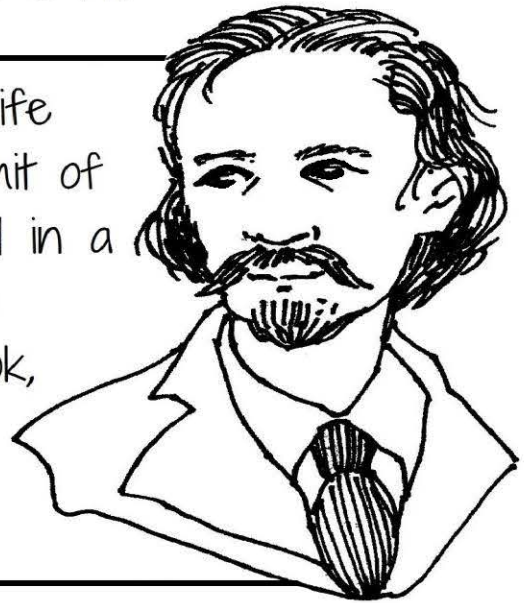


## ROBERT LOUIS STEVENSON (1850-1894)
